Give Back to Animals (10/1/23-11/30/23)- Volunteer at an animal shelter, collect donations for your local animal shelter, volunteer to walk local dogs, read to animals, make toys or bake treats for shelter animals, etc.



Give Back for the Holidays (12/1/23-1/31/24)- participate in a Christmas toy drive, write Christmas cards for local nursing homes, go caroling in a nursing home, stuff stockings, host a coat drive, etc.



Give Back and Make Someone's Day (2/1/24-3/31/24)- create birthday kits for local food pantries, write birthday cards for orphanages, collect toys for homeless children, birthday in a bag kits for nursing home, make blessings bags, etc.



Give Back to the Earth (4/1/24-5/31/24)- clean up a park, set up a recycling program, make a video about recycling or composting, plant trees, plant native flowers, create a community garden, etc.



Give Back to Those Who Serve (6/1/24-7/31/24)- make cards for veterans, participate in a wreath laying ceremony, educate others on how to properly retire an American Flag, write letters of thanks to EMTs, Firefighters, and Police Officers, etc.



Give Back to Children (8/1/24-9/30/24)- host a diaper drive, toy drive, or school supply drive, work with a local foster closet, donate books to a local little free library, make blankets for Project Linus, etc.
